

First lift and remove the rubber compartment liner.


Next remove the two screws shown here using a 7mm socket.

Insert the mounting bracket in the orientation shown and secure it reusing factory hardware.

If you plan to install the provided USB cable you can now determine the best routing path to your intended power source. This can be a factory usb power port in the dash or an aftermarket 12v-5v usb adapter and this step will vary for each installation based on your preference and accessory power needs.

Pull all slack through and press the USB adapter tight into the rectangle cutout.


